

Veritas Enterprise Vault.cloud Release Notes

Veritas is proud to announce the March 2017 release of the Enterprise Vault.cloud service suite. This quarterly release continues the ongoing theme of product improvement. The release occurs on **Friday March 24th** for the Sydney and Amsterdam data centers, **Friday March 31st** for the US data centers, and **Friday April 7th** for the South Africa datacenter.

Highlights

- Google G Suite Gmail archiving** – Enterprise Vault.cloud now supports archiving for Enterprise Gmail for customers with Google G Suite Enterprise edition. - Folder Sync for Office 365** – Folder Sync 1.12 is a new version of the on-premises application that lets you synchronize users' Office 365 mailbox folder structures to Personal.cloud. For every Office 365 mailbox that you target, each synchronization does as follows, if the mailbox has an archive account:
 - The mailbox folder structure is synchronized to Personal.cloud.
 - The archived items in Personal.cloud are moved into their synchronized folders.

- Archive Migrator 1.2** – This new version of Archive Migrator can migrate archives from Enterprise Vault 9.0.5, 10.0.4, 11.0.1, and 12.1 including any updates to 12.1. The previous restriction on the export of Enterprise Vault 9.0.5 and 10.0.4 archives larger than 2.0 TB has been removed. See <http://www.veritas.com/docs/000023456>.
- Office 365 Sync** – The Administration Console workflow for configuring and using Office 365 Sync has been enhanced. Entering the account credentials for PowerShell and EWS has been made easier, and you no longer have to supply the calling URLs. For customers with SSO enabled, a new option lets you choose whether to send welcome messages.
- Cloudlink Google account synchronization** - CloudLink 4.0.1 now includes the Google Sync feature. This feature is typically for use in environments where you use the Google Cloud Directory Sync tool (GCDS) to synchronize Active Directory users and groups to your Google G Suite domain. CloudLink 4.0.1 enables you to synchronize these Active Directory accounts to Enterprise Vault.cloud, to support Gmail archiving. Google G Suite Gmail archiving	125945	Enterprise Vault.cloud now supports archiving of Gmail for customers who use Google G Suite Enterprise edition. This includes a new deduplication logic for emails journaled from the Google platform.
Folder Sync for Office 365	Feature	Folder Sync 1.12 is a new version of the Folder Sync on-premises application that synchronizes users' Office 365 mailbox folder structures to Personal.cloud. Each synchronization does the following for every Office 365 mailbox you target that has an archive account: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The mailbox folder structure is synchronized to Personal.cloud. The archived items in Personal.cloud are moved into their synchronized folders.
Archive Migrator	150717	Archive Migrator 1.2 can now migrate archives from Enterprise Vault 9.0.5, 10.0.4, 11.0.1, and 12.1 including any updates to 12.1. The previous restriction on the export of Enterprise Vault 9.0.5 and 10.0.4 archives larger than 2.0 TB has been removed.

Office 365 Sync	124966, 136967, 125909, 127224, 137436	Enhancements to the workflow for configuring and using Office 365 Sync. Entering the account credentials for PowerShell and EWS has been made easier, and you no longer have to supply the calling URLs. Customers with SSO enabled can now choose not to send welcome messages. The "Accounts Enabled" and "Accounts Disabled" tiles on the Office 365 Config page now reflect the correct number of users enabled and disabled by O365 Sync.
Discovery.cloud Export	148151, 151939	Enhancements have been made to export to allow for PST exports larger than 20GB where additional PST files are created once the export reaches 20GB and are placed in a ZIP file for convenient download. General processing and data retrieval enhancements have been made.
Personal.cloud	149786	Corrected issue with restore from delegate archives.
Manage	115399	Corrected issue where public IP addresses were not shown in Activity Log for some events such as 'Archive Administration Provisioning Option Edit'
