Access Product Highlights

Veritas™ Access is a software-only, scale-out network-attached storage (NAS) solution for unstructured data that can be installed on any x86 commodity server and can provide access to storage via multiple network protocols for on-premise and cloud ecosystems. It provides customers with a single storage solution for many applications and has enhanced support for private and public cloud platforms such as OpenStack or Amazon Web Services.

Access Licensing Meter – Per Core

- One license is required for each “Core” where Veritas Access is deployed and running, regardless of server models and processor architecture.
- A “Core” is defined as a functional unit on a processor that reads, interprets, and executes computer instructions, including instructions from the licensed software.
- A "Core" refers to the processor or execution core contained in the same integrated circuit within a computer’s central processing unit, whether such Cores are virtual or physical.
- Only cores that are in use need to be licensed. Cores disabled at the kernel level do not require licenses.
- Virtual Server Environments:
 1. Determine the number of virtual Cores assigned to all VMs by the guest OS.
 2. Determine the number of physical Cores available to the VMs.
 3. License the minimum between the number of virtual Cores assigned to all VM instances or the number of physical Cores available to them.
