Troubleshooting Information

Gather all log files:

When reporting an issue, please run the Support Gather utilities and send all logs to Symantec.

From a terminal session change to the following directory:

```
/usr/sbin
```

And run the following command

```
./gatherLogs
```

The output file that is created is:

```
/tmp//symantec_System_recovery_for_Linux_logs.<DATE>_<TIME>.zip
```

Be sure that the following logs are a part of the gather:

```
/var/log/symsr
```
