

## Declaration of compliance with EU Batteries Directive (2006/66/EC)

The EU Batteries Directive (2006/66/EC) contains a variety of requirements regarding the material content, labeling, and recycling of batteries. The batteries supplied by Veritas in its products and as replacement parts meet the marking and heavy metal content requirements of the [EU Battery Directive](#).

More information on how Veritas meets the requirements of the Battery Directive along with safe handling information are provided below.

### Battery Replacement, Handling and Disposal

#### 1. Battery Guidance

Veritas takes great care in the selection of its batteries and where used, these have been designed specifically for use in specific Veritas products. Batteries should be treated and used in accordance with the battery manufacturer's guidance.

#### 2. Toxic Substances

The batteries supplied by Veritas in its products and as replacement parts meet the marking and heavy metal content requirements of the [EU Battery Directive](#). Where batteries include lead, mercury or cadmium, the levels of these substances are very low and fall below the thresholds that exist in all markets into which they are supplied.

#### 3. Mercury and Cadmium

The sum of concentration levels of mercury present in battery material does not exceed 0.0005% (weight percentage). The sum of concentration levels of cadmium present in battery material does not exceed 0.002% (weight percentage).

#### 4. Labeling

The EU Batteries Directive requires a crossed-out wheelee bin symbol on some product. All Veritas products are properly labeled. Batteries are marked with the wheelee bin symbol in accordance with the marking requirements of the Directive as applicable.

#### 5. Battery Disposal

When a battery has reached the end of its working life, carefully remove it from the product as instructed in the user guide. The battery should be taken to a collection point where it can be recycled or disposed of in an environmentally friendly manner.
