

## **Declaration of compliance with EU Packaging Directive**

Veritas considers itself to be an environmentally responsible company. With respect to packaging, Veritas designs its hardware and software packaging to reduce environmental impact. This includes compliance with the European Union's Directive on Packaging and Packaging Waste (94/62/EC of 20 December 1994, as amended by 2004/12/EC) and the CEN packaging standards (2005/C 44/13).

Through policies, and in close relationship with partners and suppliers, we use a system of specifications, testing, and verification to comply with applicable laws and regulations, including requirements restricting the use of certain hazardous substances, specifying recyclable material content, and restricting the use of certain wood products. We believe that we are in compliance with all applicable local, state, federal, and international environmental regulations. To the best of our knowledge, applicable hazardous substances are not present, in excess of specified threshold limits, in the parts that Veritas sells or in the packing materials used for shipping said parts.

European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC of 20 December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste requires the marking of packaging with an appropriate recycle category, the recycling of packaging waste, and require brand owners and importers of packaging to ensure that the amount of heavy metals which can be released to impact on the environment be limited in all packaging components to 100 ppm max by weight from 30/06/01 (this is the combined total for cadmium, mercury, lead and hexavalent chromium). Veritas products fully meet these requirements.

Veritas will ensure that all our products meet all the requirements of the packaging Directive (94/62/EC + amendments) and all the relevant markings are placed on the packaging.

Veritas verifies compliance by requesting Declarations of Compliance from our raw material suppliers, reporting the total concentration of the four restricted heavy metals: lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium.
