A move with a focus on the future: 100% digitalized services

In 2021, the municipal government of Recife had to do something important: the physical migration of its equipment and systems — responsible for data processing and communication — to a new Data Processing Center: the TIER III Data Center.

This complex work, however, presented some challenges. One was to ensure a migration that was secure enough so that data and information remained safe and secure.

After all, it was the transfer of all the equipment where the systems, data, and applications of the municipal government of Recife are stored, in addition to 300 links and units managed by Empresa Municipal de Informática de Recife (Emprel). Being responsible for the move, Emprel is in charge of the planning and implementation of the Information Technology and Communication policy of the local government of Recife.

The challenges imposed by the move to a container dedicated to the Data Center made Emprel make backup a priority for the project, and the complexity of this action also demanded a reliable and sufficiently robust solution.

It was in this context that the partnership between the local government of Recife and Veritas began. The first contact with Emprel took place through a company called Arvvo Tecnologia, during an industry event.

According to Jorge Pinto, director of IT infrastructure at Emprel, the decision for Veritas was made because the company offered the best management and data security strategy for the current demand.

The path to digitalization of 100% of public services in Recife

For André Silva, regional director at Arvvo, the company responsible for the implementation strategy related to Veritas solutions, the transfer of the Data Center was an important step towards modernizing the city's data storage structure. "Initially, Veritas technology would only be used during the move. But, given the success we had, the partnership was expanded, becoming an important pillar for the vision of digital government of the local government of Recife", he said.

In the last five years, there has been a significant advance in digital transformation in the city of Recife. This progress, however, generated impacts and signaled the need for changes, such as adapting the infrastructure to provide digitalized services.

With the restrictions on in-person services due to the pandemic, the demand for online services has grown exponentially, and the need to increase the security and resilience of the technological platform has become even more evident.

In 2021, the "Conecta Recife" app, developed and managed by Emprel, surpassed 20 million hits and 600,000 downloads. The application offers more than 170 services to the citizens of Recife and the number of people who access the app has grown after the inclusion of the covid-19 vaccine scheduling service.



According to Jorge Pinto, the Data Center houses data from municipal management and from all government departments and agencies and, with the advancement of digitalization of services, it began to receive even greater attention.



We believe that it is extremely important for Emprel to evolve to support the new demands. Technologies and a state-of-the-art backup are critical.”
