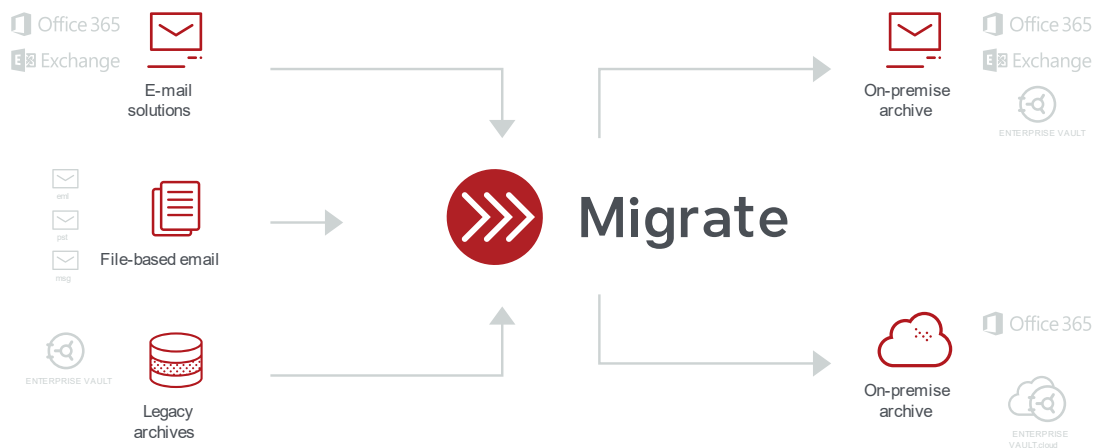


ABOUT MIGRATE

Enhancement

- The *Thread Count* field has been added to the O365 target Advanced tab to control the number of threads.

Bug Fixes

- An issue with the **Office 365 Target** has been addressed where the processing was interrupted, and manual intervention was required when the token expired.
- The "Key Not Found Exception" error has been fixed for the EML target migration.
- An issue with EV to O365 migration has been resolved where the status of a message was not changed to "Cannot Migrate" and was reported as "Remaining" in case of corrupt attachments.
