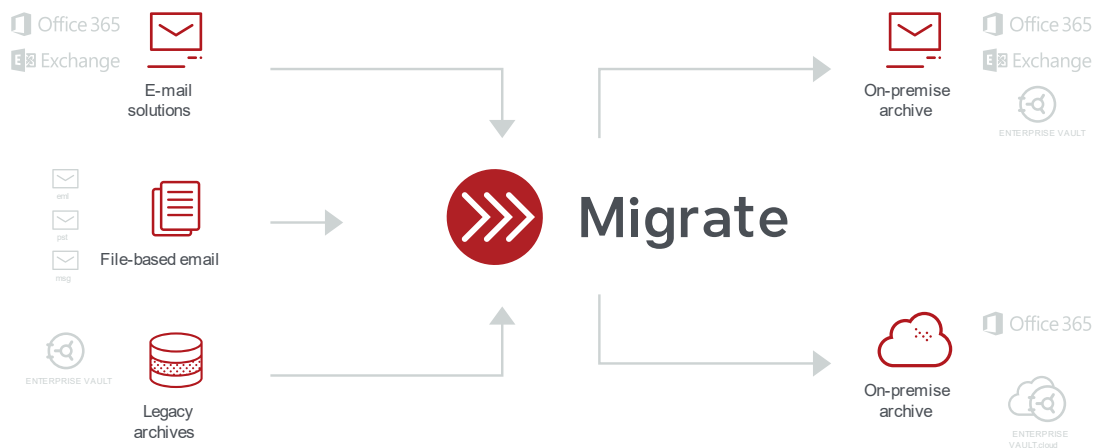


## New Features

- Validation logic has been implemented to make sure that the message retrieved from the source has the minimum fields to be considered a message.

This feature will also allow quarantining messages in a separate folder due to the missing/invalid values in the specific message parts before migration.

It is implemented for EML, EV, EWS, MSG, PST, and Office365 sources and is applied to the following message parts:

- From
- Date
- At least one recipient field (To, CC or BCC).

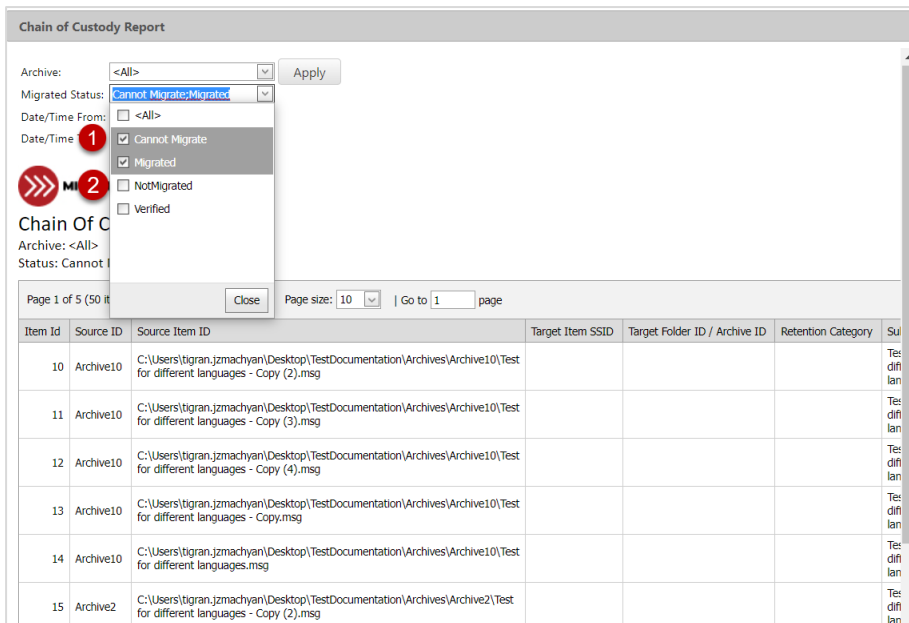

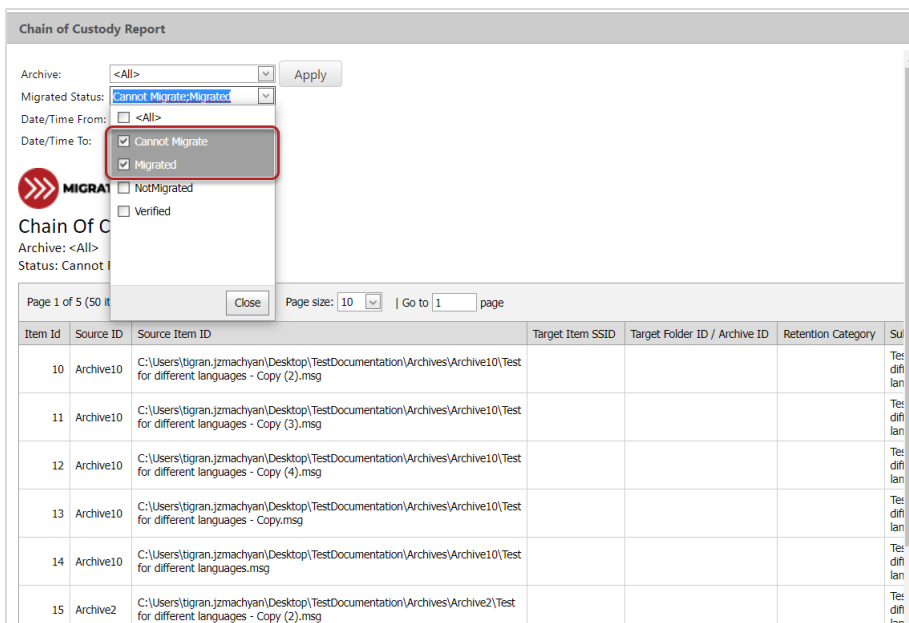
