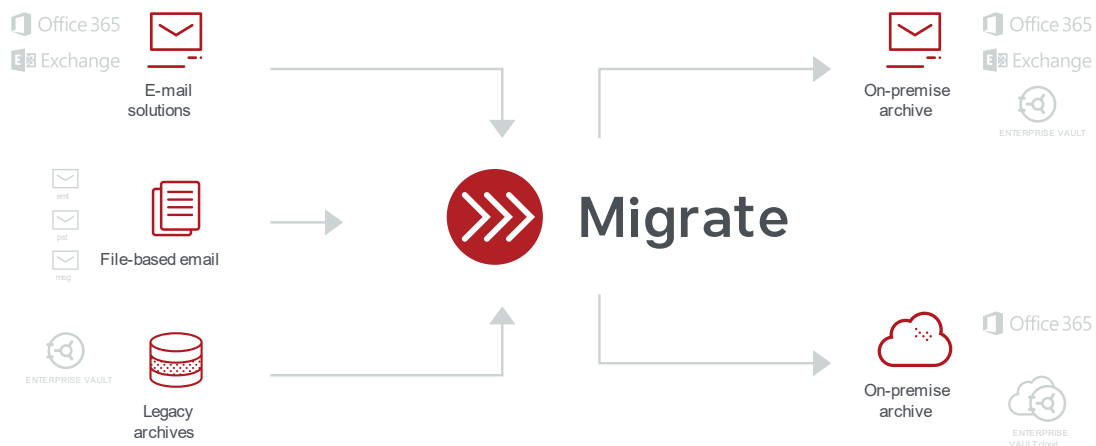

# ABOUT MIGRATE

Migrate is a data migration software developed to move data effectively and quickly between various sources and targets. We provide data migration services to organizations across all verticals, including hospitality, financial, and governmental institutions. Among some of the sources are EV, EWS, EML, MSG, PST, Office 365, and so forth.



## Enhancement

- The SQL database has been optimized for better migration performance.
- CommitSize and Interval are now configurable from Migrate Processor config file.
- To prevent any possible deadlocks, statistical stored procedures now run WITH (NOLOCK).
- Synchronization between multiple Nodes has been enhanced to improve the EML Folder Capacity preservation.
- Service Broker is now enabled during the upgrade/installation.
- To prevent the loss of connection between the Node and the Manager, the 'FaultException' is now thrown instead of 'Exception'.

## Bug Fixes

- An issue has been addressed where the task did not stop during Office to O365 Migrations.
- An issue has been addressed where an error with 'FailedArchivePreparationException' message was thrown in case of multithreading.
- An issue with the O365 Target has been addressed where an error with 'The given key was not present in the dictionary' message was thrown in case the names of the Inbox or Calendar folders were not in English.
- An issue has been fixed where *Unset Selected* did not work in case the Migrated Item Count was 1.
- An issue with the Rollover Logic has been fixed to have it applied only for the EML Target.

- An issue has been resolved where an error with 'Cannot insert duplicate key in object 'dbo.ItemMetadata' message was thrown during enumeration.
- An issue has been addressed where Status Filter did not work in Archive Manager.
- An issue has been resolved where 0 was displayed instead of message ID in logs.
- An issue with the EV to EML migration with Envelop Reconstructor has been fixed.
